

Impulse Scallop Shawl

Materials:

- 400 grams / 1600 yards Weight 2 yarn in color of your choice
- 1 Size US 6 16" Circular Knitting Needles
- Darning Needle

Increase Pattern:

The increase pattern is referenced as INC in the main pattern.

Row 1: KFB, K across

Row 2: K across

Decrease Pattern:

The decrease pattern is referenced as DEC in the main pattern.

Row 1: SKPSSO, K across

Row 2: K across

Wedge Pattern:

The wedge pattern is referenced as WEDGE in the main pattern.

Row 1: K10, wrap and turn, K back

Row 2: K20, wrap and turn, K back

Row 3: K30, wrap and turn, K back

Row 4: K40, wrap and turn, K back

Row 5: K50, wrap and turn, K back *(For the first and last wedge you will not wrap and turn this row as there are only 50 stitches across)*

Row 6: K40, wrap and turn, K back

Row 7: K30, wrap and turn, K back

Row 8: K20, wrap and turn, K back

Row 9: K10, wrap and turn, K back

Main Shawl Pattern:

Cast on 3 stitches and K across for 4 rows

Follow Increase Pattern to 50 stitches, ending with a Row 2.

INC to 60 stitches

WEDGE

INC to 70 stitches

WEDGE

INC to 80 stitches

WEDGE

INC to 90 stitches

WEDGE

INC to 100 stitches

WEDGE

INC to 110 stitches

WEDGE

INC to 120 stitches

WEDGE

DEC to 110 stitches

WEDGE

DEC to 100 stitches

WEDGE

DEC to 90 stitches

WEDGE

DEC to 80 stitches

WEDGE

DEC to 70 stitches

WEDGE

DEC to 60 stitches

WEDGE

DEC to 50 stitches

WEDGE

DEC to 3 stitches

K across for 4 rows and bind off.

Weave in ends and block if desired.
